Vaccination

Is it mandatory that attendees be fully vaccinated to attend in person?

While CREA encourages attendees to be vaccinated against COVID-19, as recommended by the Ministry of Health and Provincial Health Officers, it is not mandatory for attendees to be fully vaccinated to attend the event in person.

However, in consideration of the safety and well-being of other attendees, CREA asks that anyone who is feeling ill or experiencing any symptoms in the days leading up to the event, or during the event itself, not attend in person or remove themselves as soon as possible.

CREA's AGM will be held in a hybrid format, so attendees who are not able to attend in person, or who remove themselves, will have the opportunity to join virtually.

Masks

Must Masks be Worn?

CREA will be following provincial requirements when it comes to masks. As of June 11, 2022, the Ontario Government has lifted masking requirements in most public settings. However, individuals are encouraged to wear a mask if, in their judgement, it is right for them.
