TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ACCEPTANCE: The acceptance of the application shall be at the discretion of the Trillium Health Partners, and upon acceptance, becomes a contract. By completing and signing the application, Company agrees to comply with, and be subject to, the terms and conditions set out below (the "Terms"). Trillium Health Partners reserves the right to refuse or deny sponsorships to prospective companies.

PAYMENT: Once full payment has been received, sponsorship will be confirmed and an invoice will be issued. All prices are in CAD and are inclusive of processing related fees. Sponsorship packages are subject to availability.

CANCELLATION OR TERMINATION BY TRILLIUM HEALTH PARTNERS: If for any reason beyond its reasonable control, including without limitation fire, strike, earthquake, damage, construction or renovation to the display site, government regulation, public catastrophe, or act of God ("Force Majeure"), Trillium Health Partners shall determine that the Conference or any part will not be held, Trillium Health Partners may cancel the Conference or any part thereof. In that event, the liability of Trillium Health Partners is limited to the sponsorship amount paid by Company, less any expenses incurred by Trillium Health Partners.
