Abstract Submission Guidelines

Presentation Formats

There are two types of presentations for which you can submit an abstract, described in detail below:

- Poster Presentation
- Quick Hits

1. Poster Presentation

Poster Presentations will be displayed in two ways:

- Physical Poster Display (in-person)
 - Physical posters will be displayed at the Peter Gilgan Centre for Research and Learning and on the conference website.
 - Displays may consist of a one-piece poster, or a two dimensional collection of smaller pieces which utilize the panel as a background
 - Posters must be HORIZONTAL. The display's overall size must not exceed the panel dimensions (72" wide x 36" high or 6ft x 3ft)
 - Handouts may not be left on the floor in front of the display, however, business card or brochure holders may be attached to the display panel.
 - We will provide you with the "male" or "hook" Velcro or pins needed to attach your poster to the poster boards
 - You are responsible for all expenses associated with creating your poster presentation, conference registration and travel expenses for the conference
 - You are responsible for setting up your poster during morning registration on Saturday September 30, 2023
 - Displays will be showcased during the conference breaks and lunch. We ask that a representative be present at the poster during these times
- Virtual Display (on conference website)
 - We suggest that you create your poster in PowerPoint. Widescreen slide size will give you more space but either widescreen 16:9 or standard 4:3 aspect ratios will be fine. You can then create a PDF of the poster for us to display on the Poster tab of this website.
 - Conference delegates will be invited to view the posters and pose text based questions or comments on the e-poster webpage for one week prior to the conference and poster viewing will remain open for 30 days following the conference.
 - Poster presenters will be encouraged to interact and respond to questions posed on the e-poster webpage for one week prior to the conference

2. Quick Hits

- These abstracts are delivered orally as part of the conference agenda to the entire conference audience.
- 3 minute presentation followed by 2 minutes live Q & A discussion with the audience, 5 minutes total.
