

AFPC Faculty Membership Criteria 2023

FACULTY	CRITERIA
British Columbia	All UBC Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences faculty members eligible to vote at our monthly Faculty Advisory Council meeting will be considered eligible for AFPC membership
Alberta	 All Faculty-paid academic staff members (both tenure track and non-tenure track, and APO with duties relating directly to the education of student pharmacists (e.g., teaching, experiential, etc.) appointed at 0.4 FTE or greater
Saskatchewan	 All tenured and tenure track faculty All ASPA personnel with instructional appointments (these are our lab instructors for instance, who are not included in our faculty union nor are they tenure-track) All continuing sessional instructor personnel All Experiential Learning, Continuing Professional Development for Pharmacy Professionals (CPDPP), medSask, Medication Assessment Centre (MAC), and RxFiles professional staff members
Manitoba	All Faculty-paid academic staff (tenured, tenure track and non-tenure track) at FTE 0.5 or higher
Waterloo	Full- and part-time faculty, lecturers and staff involved in teaching/assessment will be eligible for membership in the Association of Faculties of Pharmacy of Canada
Toronto	 All academic staff members (tenure track, teaching track, contract limited teaching appointments) with full or part-time appointments at the Faculty All Status-only faculty members All Adjunct Lecturer and Adjunct Professor faculty members All Program Directors with membership in Faculty Council
Ottawa	 Regular professors (assistant, associate and full) Clinical professors (assistant, associate and full)
Montreal	Professors (assistant, associate and full), Clinical professors (assistant, associate and full)
Laval	 Professors (adjoint, agrégés, titulaires et émérites) (i.e.assistant, associate, full and emeritus) Clinical professors (adjoint, agrégé et titulaire) (i.e., assitant, associate and full) Charges d'enseignement, responsable de formation pratique et chargés de cours
Dalhousie	Members must have a full or part time appointment at the College of Pharmacy and must be involved in teaching students, research or administration
Memorial	 Individuals meeting one of the following criteria are deemed to be members of AFPC: All faculty-paid academic staff (tenured, tenure track, and non-tenure track) at 0.4 FTE or higher Pharmacy practice experience coordinator Clinical assistant professors
