





# Canadians want a stronger economy that delivers a better, more affordable standard of living



What is your greatest **hope** for Prime Minister Mark Carney and the newly elected Liberal government?[OPEN ENDED] [n=1,000]




What is your greatest **fear** about Prime Minister Mark Carney and the newly elected Liberal government?[OPEN-ENDED][ n=1,000]




# Canadians are will to pay more, but more uncertainty in Alberta

Over the next 25 years, the amount of electricity being used in [PROV] is expected to rise significantly. This will require electricity companies to make significant investments in the electricity system.



Generally speaking, would your initial reaction be to support or oppose a proposal to build each of the following projects in your province? [asked of all respondents]






## Over 60% in Alberta and Nationally support pumped storage projects

Generally speaking, would your initial reaction be to support or oppose a proposal to build each of the following projects in your province?:


Pumped hydro storage that uses excess electricity to pump water uphill into a reservoir and uses that water to generate electricity when it is needed.




#### Pluralities support battery storage in Alberta and across Canada


Generally speaking, would your initial reaction be to support or oppose a proposal to build each of the following projects in your province?: Large scale battery storage




## The Hurdles: Five 'Veto' questions that drive project legitimacy



#### The power of the 'Veto' questions



#### Summing it up

- 1. This is a unique moment where both elites and average people see the need to invest in our energy infrastructure.
- 2. While initial support is high, individual projects remain at risk from criticism on the details of their projects. This is particularly true for battery storage which has much higher levels of uncertainty.
- 3. Generally, Alberta is just as supportive of energy storage as the rest of the country.
