About the NCLP

Since 1974, the National Criminal Law Program has been Canada's largest and most prestigious criminal law conference. Drawing 500 + leading legal professionals—Crown and defence counsel, judges, and police—it offers a rich five-day program of plenaries, panels, debates, demonstrations, workshops, and breakout sessions.

Rotating through three themes (Substantive Law, Criminal Procedure and the Charter, and Evidence), the 2026 Program will focus on Evidence, Ethics and the Administration of Justice. Attendees can typically fulfill all their annual CLE requirements through the NCLP.

The 45+ Faculty group includes top prosecutors, defence counsel, and judges from across Canada, with participation from Supreme Court justices past and present where available. Each year, faculty prepare around 80 papers, consistently cited as valuable tools for practice and judicial work.

What does partnership with the NCLP look like?


Our attendees value staying current with technology, legal literature, and innovations in the field. The following page highlights attendee demographics and recent registration totals.



Sponsors will have name associated with the event in the program and onsite signage, attend the event, make short remarks, and can provide simple materials to attendees.





Shipping Shipping instructions will be provided closer to the conference date. Exhibitor is responsible for their own shipping, handling, storage, event production, and AV costs.

Prize Draws Exhibitors are encouraged to offer prize draws at their booths. Exhibitors are responsible for timing of their draws and contacting winners as well as arranging for prize collection.

In 2025 we introduced a game through the Mobile App which we intend to reproduce in 2026. This draw would be entered into by attendees who scan QR codes at each of the participating booths. Top scorers would receive prizes of varying value dependant on contributions from exhibitors. The NCLP will include a free registration to the 2027 NCLP as a top prize.

Attendance Each booth can have up to 2 staff members in attendance throughout the week. Names for badges must be provided by June 6th. There may be a charge for additional staff. Please note, these are for Exhibit staff only, and not complimentary registrations for you to give away to non-Exhibit staff. Exhibit staff onsite will have access to the conference health breaks and breakfasts as provided to attendees.

Hotel Exhibitors will be provided with a link to book accommodation at our conference hotels. If our group blocks sell out, exhibitors will be responsible for finding alternate accommodation. We advise you to book early.
